

Trade-offs related to forest use in the south Swedish landscape

September 13th- 17th 2010 Future Forests Week is arranged for the second time. This time it is placed in the vicinity of Asa, Småland, and focus is on trade-offs related to forest use in the south Swedish landscape. Invited to participate are researchers and practitioners directly involved in the research program Future Forests, plus representatives from the media.

Participation is free. Future Forests will cover costs for food, accommodation and transports between Växjö/Alvesta and Asa. Travel costs to and from Växjö/Alvesta are on your own, if you are not members of the Board, the Scientific Advisory Board or the Panel of Practitioners for which the program will cover the costs. Asa is located 40 km from Växjö and 45 km from Alvesta.
